Creating a sense of connection between the natural and the artificial, "Selfing Nature" inspired viewers to think about digital portals. As an invitation to step into a dimension animated by organic beauty, the frame was intentionally devoid of a screen.

As spectators encountered "Selfing Nature" within the Korean landscape, they were compelled to ponder the boundaries of their digital encounters. The vacant frame beckoned them to immerse themselves in a realm where the influence of screens was stripped away, facilitating an unfiltered communion with the organic world.

My installation sought to mirror the ongoing discourse between technology and nature within the digital era. By using the mobile phone frame as a metaphorical bridge, I sought to bridge the gap between art and technology.
